### Purpose of the Role

To prepare materials and manufacture, by use of hand and power tools, wood, metal fabricated/welded and composite structures. All work carried out to the highest standards from verbal, written or drawing specifications.

### Key Responsibilities

- Accurate preparation of materials by cutting, grinding bending, folding and drilling to form parts against drawings, sketches or verbal instruction
- Accurate machining of parts using; Lathe, Miller and Surface Grinder
- Accurate assembling of parts using appropriate fixings
- Accurate fabrication of mechanical parts
- Preparation and painting of bare material when necessary
